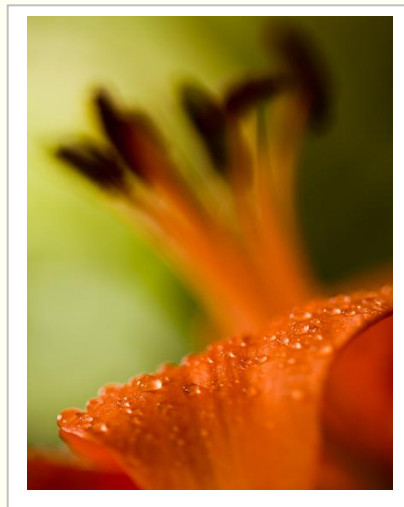

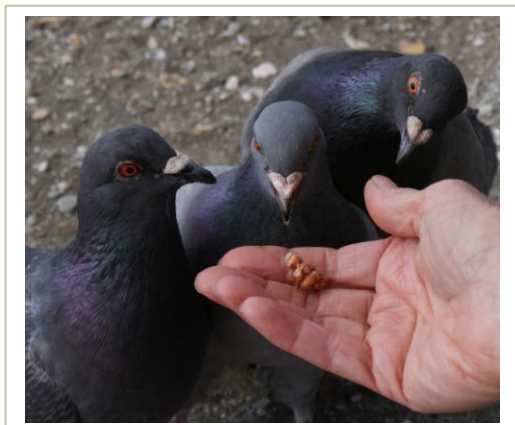

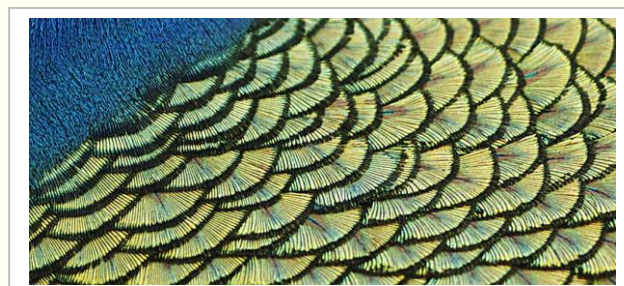

CS5 costs \$1520.00 (approx) and Elements to costs \$90.00 (approx)

CS5 has advanced noise reduction, so does light-room and now Elements 9 and 10

CS5 has HDR abilities, so do many programs and now Elements 9 and 10

Content aware etc was first released in Photoshop but now in Elements

Photoshop can do a lot more than Elements that covers video, web building, and graphic art etc but for a photographer do you really need all of that? Elements can now do all the effects, filters and adjustments CS5 can do

Download Elements 10 for free 30 day trial and try it out. You could save a lot of money

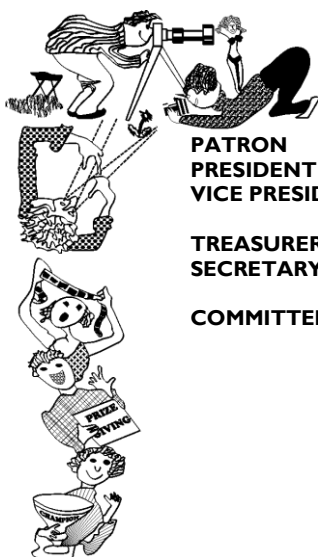
