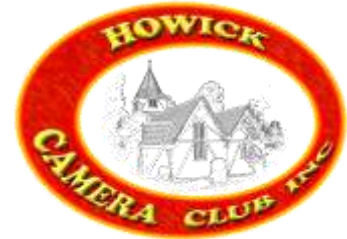

He was a real "gentleman" and a true enthusiast who loved the Arts in all forms. He had a very generous nature and his criticisms were always helpful and sincere, and he had a wonderful knowledge of photographic techniques.

In saying that we have to remember that cameras were all mechanical in those days. No auto focus or exposure, and professionals nearly always used plate cameras for their serious work. Frank was a member of the Auckland Photographic Society and also P.S.N.Z. I remember him well, and it is my very great pleasure to be able to say that I was acquainted with him, and always enjoyed his company. I have not yet seen this Exhibition of Frank's images but I'm sure it will be worth visiting to re-acquaint myself with his fine skills.
